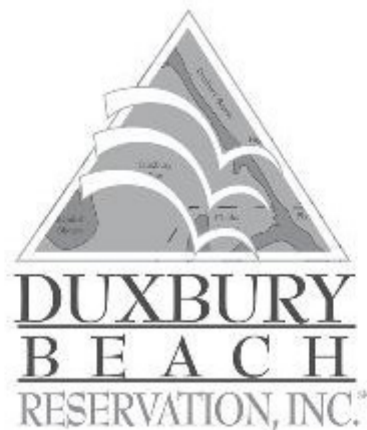


## DUXBURY
